




Q2 What is your age?







Q5 What is the highest level of education you have achieved?





Q6 If you have a degree or certificate in paralegal studies, is it from an ABA-accredited program?






Q14 How many years have you worked for your current employer?

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


Q16 How many attorneys are employed by your firm/company?



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Q20 Do you perform some secretarial/administrative support for others as a part of your job description?




Q21 Do you supervise others as a part of your job description?

Q22 Which best describes the source of most of your work?






Q29 Are your PTO/Vacation days based on the length of time with you employer?



Q30 Does your employer pay for outside paralegal training (CLE)?





Q31 Does your employer provide in-house paralegal training?





Q32 Does your employer pay for outside technology training?





Q34 Does your employer allow you to work remotely on a regular basis?










